Please attach your answers to the following questions. Be brief and concise. Please use 12 point type. Total written response should not exceed two (2) 8.5 x 11 pages. See attached rubric for scoring criteria.

- a. In a brief paragraph, summarize your teaching enrichment project.

II. NARRATIVE:

- a. What need does your project address? What are the goals & anticipated educational outcomes?
- b. What methods and activities will you use?
- c. Which Standards & Benchmarks are supported by your project? (Be specific.)
- d. How will you evaluate the effectiveness of your teaching enrichment project?
- e. How will parents and the community be involved?
- f. If you receive a grant, what, specifically, will you do to publicize and promote REEF?

III. TIMELINE:

- a. What is the timeline for your project?

IV. BUDGET:

Educators and students have a wealth of ideas on how to enrich learning experiences thus reaching more students and improving achievement. The Bonnie G. Polis & Carpenter Teaching Enrichment Grants Programs are intended to support teachers and students throughout RUSD. We award funds to creative teachers, students and staff so they can see their ideas become a reality.

WHO MAY APPLY

Teachers, students, and staff of the Riverside Unified School District may apply for grant funds.

GRANT FUNDING

The Riverside Educational Enrichment Foundation will award grants of up to \$1,000 for an individual teacher and up to \$3,000 for grade-level teacher teams or school-wide programs. Cost-effective proposals are favored.

APPLICATION DUE DATE

All applications are due by 4:00 p.m., Monday, September 14, 2018. Grant recipients will be notified by October 19, 2018 via email.

PROPOSAL GUIDELINES

Only projects with standards-based educational content will be considered.

- Proposals must benefit the students of Riverside Unified School District.
- Projects promoting effective practices focused on increasing student achievement will be given priority.
- Parent and/or community involvement will strengthen a proposal.
- Proposals with potential impact beyond the initial grant period will be favored.
- The goals of the proposal must be consistent with the goals of the District's instructional program.
- Grants may be used to purchase equipment ONLY when these are components of a larger project.
- Proposals for funds to purchase technology hardware such as: iPads, computers, document cameras or projectors are considered "base program", therefore proposals for funds to purchase these items will not be considered for funding.
- Grant funds must supplement, not replace, state or local funds.

Proposals MUST be typed and received by the grant deadline to be considered. The application is accessible online: reef4rusd.org

- If a teacher's position or school changes, notify the REEF Board of Directors so that the individual grant may be reviewed for implementation purposes.
- **Submit 5 copies of the application/proposal including cover page.**
- Duplicate grants submitted by different teachers will not be accepted. If teachers are working together on a grant, it must be on the same application.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Grant proposals may be partially funded
- A written evaluation (with photographs) is required of all grant recipients following completion of the funded programs. Copies of receipts must be included with final evaluation, to be submitted no later than May 30, 2019.
- Any remaining balance in a funded grant may be used for classroom supplies at the discretion of the teacher and site principal.



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ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE TYPED and must be received by the grant deadline: September 14, 2018. Please submit 5 copies of the completed application with a copy of this cover sheet on each. If 5 copies are not submitted, the application will not be considered. Applications placed in folders will not be accepted. Staple each application separately and paperclip or rubber band the 5 copies together.
